

On-Line Scorekeeper Test Instructions

2007-2008 Season

Go to the Badger Region website: www.badgerregionvolleyball.org. Go to the Volleyball Officiating Tab. On the drop down menu, select "Scorekeeper Certification". On this page scroll down to the section called "Adult/Junior Provisional Scorekeeping Certification Requirements". There you will find a link to the Scorekeeper test: <http://www.yankee.org/scorers/usavtest/index.html>. Once you click on the link, you will be directed to the test site.

Test Website Instructions

Once you are at the linked website for the test, select "On-line" test under 2007-2008 USAV Volleyball Theoretical Exam Form C. The site will take you directly to a form to fill out before you can take the test.

Test Form Instructions

Once you have arrived at the next screen, you will be asked to provide your personal information.

Contact Information, USAV/Region Password and Scorekeeper Rating

At the top of the form, you will need to fill in your name, address, phone number and email address. Select "Badger Region" from the drop down menu. **Enter the Badger Region password: BGD278S.**

Select your rating level. If you do not know your rating level, please contact the Scorekeeper Chair at: paulsonn@wi.rr.com. If your level is In-Training (all **new** scorekeepers) or Junior Olympic (under 18), please select the "Not Yet Certified" category. **Note:** if you are taking the test for re-certification, enter your prior year rating level. Current certification level information can be found on the Badger Region website under the "Volleyball Officiating, Referee List" drop down link.

After all information has been entered, scroll down and begin the test.

Taking the Referee Test

Answer all 50 test questions. After completing the test, submit the test by selecting "Submit Answers". This will take you to another window to confirm submission of the completed test. Select the confirmation button. **Note:** If you select the back button, the test will be reset, removing prior answers.

The test will automatically be corrected and you will receive your results automatically via the email address you provide. A copy of your answers will also be emailed to the Scorekeeper Chair.

You will also receive an email indicating the answers you got wrong. These answers must be corrected and include a rule reference. The email will indicate to whom you need to send the corrections (all corrections will go to the Scorekeeper Chair (paulsonn@wi.rr.com)). **In order for you to be considered to have completed the test, you must submit the corrections.**
